

249763. *ORYZOPSIS HOLCIFORMIS* (Bieb.) Hack. Poaceae. **Ricegrass.**

Col. No. 17143. Dry rocky soil, Menidhion. Elevation 500 feet. Perennial bunchgrass.

249764. *POA NEMORALIS* L. Poaceae. **Wood bluegrass.**

Col. No. 17088. Near Karyai, Athos. Elevation 2,000 feet. Coarse, succulent, perennial to three feet high.

249765. *POA HYBRIDA* Gaud. **Bluegrass.**

Col. No. 17086. Open granitic slope, Karyai, Athos. Elevation 1,800 feet. Succulent perennial in chestnut forest.

249766. *POA PRATENSIS* L. **Kentucky bluegrass.**

Col. No. 17091. Athos Mountains. Elevation 2,500 feet. Tall perennial; culms leafy and thick.

249767. *VICIA ANGUSTIFOLIA* L. Fabaceae. **Narrowleaf vetch.**

Col. No. 17041. San Dimitros, Olympus. Elevation 2,700 feet. Winter-spring annual; seed pods narrow.

249768. *VICIA* sp.

Col. No. 17081. Karyai, Athos. Elevation 1,800 feet. Plants large and bushy; flowers with purple banners and pale keels.

249769 to 249807. *COLEUS BLUMEI* var. *VERSCHAFFELTII* Lem. **Menthaceae.**

249769. 'Afterglow'.

249770. 'Autumn'. Uniform reddish brown; a slow grower.

249771. 'Beauty'. Dark brown, edges turning red. A dark sport of 'Paisley Shawl'.

249772. 'Beckwith's Gem'. Leaves brown, edged green, turning crimson with pale yellow edge.

249773. 'Blackburn'.

249774. 'Bizarre Croton'. Bushy habit, medium vigour; leaves small narrow, green and white splashed with red and brown.

249775. 'Campfire'. Vigorous branching habit; leaves green, splashed brown; edges turning red and yellow.

249776. 'Celia'. Short bushy habit; leaves light chestnut brown with narrow frilled yellow-green edge.

249777. 'Crimson Velvet'. Leaves frilled, edge dark brown, center red. A good grower.

249778. 'Cristata'. Leaves frilled, green, center white.

249779. 'Dominant'.

249780. 'Doris'. A good grower; leaf center medium pink, edge medium green.

249781. 'Etna'. Leaves reddish brown, edge turning bright red. A dark sport of 'Campfire'.

249782. 'Excellent'. Leaves medium sized; edge dark brown, center red, plant of medium vigor.

249783. 'Freckles'. Leaves light yellow-green, splashed with shades of light brown, unusual.

249784. 'Glitter'. Leaves brown, edge green, turning red with golden yellow.

249785. 'Glory of Luxemborg'. Leaves bright chocolate-brown with narrow yellow-green crimped edge.
