251705. *TRIFOLIUM APERTUM* Bobr. Fabaceae.

No. 27313. Plant annual, erect, usually branching close to the ground; leaves hairy on the upper side, superior leaves minutely dentate; stipules elongate, sublinear and acuminate, margins clearly pilose; peduncle appressed after flowering and elongate; petals 1.5-4 cm. long and 0.5-1.5 cm. wide; corolla yellow, tube sparingly pilose; pod one-seeded, slightly curved, 1 4-15 mm. long, coriaceous or membranous. Flowers in June and fruits in July. Habitat: along edge of woods and in thickets, Caucasus. The wild form resembles *T. alexandrinum*.

No. 45. 'Zarzamora'. Boquete, Panama. Elevation 4,000 feet. Fruits red, 1.5 inches long. Thirty-one almost black fruits on sprig from which seeds were taken. Bears throughout year.

251719. *RUBUS* sp.

No. 48. 'Zarzamora'. Cero Punter, Panama. Elevation 5,000 feet. Semi-trailing, resembling native Louisiana blackberry. Fruits black when ripe.
