**253449.** Col. No. 17430. University Botanical Garden, Ljubljana, Slovenia. Elevation 1,000 feet. Hardy and long-lived rhizomatous perennial, forming a small rounded bush to 15 inches high.

**253450.** Col. No. 17452. Sweta Gora near Gorica, Slovenia. Elevation 1,700 feet. Rhizomatous perennial forming wide-spreading thickets.

**253451. MEDICAGO SATIVA L.****Alfalfa.**

Col. No. 17455. Rocky ground near Gorica, Slovenia. Elevation 1,700 feet. Spontaneous.

**253452. MEDICAGO sp.**

Col. No. 17451. Bluff above the beach, Koper, Slovenia. Elevation 15 feet. Spontaneous.

**253453. MELICA CILIATA L. Poaceae.**

Col. No. 17435. Rocky slopes, Predjama, Slovenia. Elevation 1,700 feet. Ornamental perennial grass.

**253454. MELILOTUS ALBA Desr. Fabaceae.****White sweetclover.**

Col. No. 17489. Sava River Valley, Serbia. Elevation 500 feet.

**253455. POA sp. Poaceae.**

Col. No. 17364. Kupres Valley, Bosnia. Elevation 3,800 feet. Perennial; leaves long, tender, wiry.

**253456. SANGUISORBA sp. Rosaceae.**

Col. No. 17449. Along dry slope, Koper, Slovenia. Elevation 50 feet. Perennial.

**253457. SESBANIA sp. Fabaceae.**

Col. No. 17420. Fourteen miles east of Rijeka. Elevation 3,000 feet. Small, leafy perennial; stems to 15 inches.

**253458. TETRAGONOLOBUS SILIQUOSUS (L.) Roth Fabaceae.**

Col. No. 17478. Jasenice, Slovenia. Elevation 1,900 feet. Perennial; stems decumbent.

**253459. VICIA sp. Fabaceae.**

Col. No. 17421. Twenty miles north of Rijeka, Slovenia. Elevation 1,500 feet. Fine-leaved perennial bush.

**253460. VICIA sp.**

Col. No. 17424. Ljubljana, Slovenia. Elevation 1,000 feet.

**253461. VICIA sp.**

Col. No. 17436. Predjama, Slovenia. Elevation 1,700 feet. Erect, leafy, glaucous perennial to three feet high.

**253462. VICIA sp.**

Col. No. 17475. Jasenice, Slovenia. Elevation 1,900 feet. Climbing annual; flowers purple.

**253463. ALLIUM sp. Liliaceae.**

Col. No. K1971. Hills west of Jordan River, near Havat Shemuel, Israel. Plant to 30 inches high.

**253464. ALLIUM sp.**

Col. No. K2013. Five miles southwest of Ougda, Morocco. Plants to 15 inches high.
