304965. *CALEA UNIFLORA* Less. Compositae.

No. 44519. Shore areas near junction of Plata and Uruguay Rivers. Perennial. Frequent on sandy soils, heavy seeder.

Pakistan Project A17-CR-5.

304966. *CALENDULA ARVENSIS* L. Compositae.

No. 42627. Rawalpindi. Erect annual 12-20 inches high.

304967. *CARDAMINE IMPATIENS* L. Cruciferae.

No. 43901. Near Abbottabad, Hazara District. Slender, erect annual. Flowers small, white; pods nearly erect.

304968. *CREPIS THOMPSONII* Babcock Compositae.

No. 44779. Lawrencepur, Campbellpur District. Annual. A plant of drier plains region.

304969. *LAMIUM AMPLEXICAULE* L. Labiatae. **Henbit.**

No. 43326. Rawalpindi. Prostrate annual, weedy tendencies, 12-18 inches high. Found in grainfields from plains up to 9,000 feet elevation.

304970. *OENOTHERA ROSEA* Soland Onagraceae. **Rose sundrops.**

No. 44136. Murree hills. Elevation 6,000 feet. Annual.

304971. *PAPAVER HYBRIDUM* L. Papaveraceae.

No. 43907. Lawrencepur, Campbellpur District. Annual. Common in cultivated fields and along roadsides February-April. Small brick red flowers, hispid capsules.

304972. *SAUSSUREA CANDICANS* C.B. Clarke Compositae.

No. 43794. Ayub National Park, Rawalpindi. Tall, erect herb, presumably annual. Cottony leaves, reddish flowers; found in plains and up to 7,000 feet elevation.

304973. *CREPIS BIENNIS* L. Compositae.

No. 45124. Jahorina Mountains, Bosniai Hercegovina Republic. Biennial.

304974. *CREPIS KITAIBELII* Froel. ex DC.

No. 45387. * Velebit Mountains, Croatia Republic. Biennial.

From the United States.

304975. *CREPIS OCCIDENTALIS* Nutt.

No. 45518. Along U.S. Highway 299 about one mile south of Alturas, Calif. Perennial, heavy seeder.

304976. *CREPIS RUBRA* L.

No. 43328. G. W. Park Seed Company, Greenwood, S. C. Branching annual to 1.5 feet high.

304977. *LOBULARIA MARITIMA* Desv. Cruciferae.

No. 40229. Herbst Brothers, Importers, New York City. Grown as annual. Plant prostrate, flower racemes rise 8-12 inches.
