306242. *CALOPOGONIUM MUCUNOIDES* Desv. Leguminosae.

Collected in Cuiaba, Mato Grosso. Very heavy growth, strong soil. Pasture legume.

306243 and 306244. *CASSIA PATELLARIA* DC. Leguminosae.

306243. Collected near Cuiaba, Mato Grosso. Possible pasture or wild-life use in Florida or Gulf States.

306244. Collected near Campinas. Possible pasture or wildlife use in Florida or Gulf states.

306245. *CENCHURUS* sp. Gramineae.

Near Campinas along road. Plant to 2 feet high, leaves to 0.5 inch wide, thick foliage, appears very succulent.

306246 and 306247. *CROTALARIA INCANA* L. Leguminosae.

306246. Collected near Cuiaba, Mato Grosso. Excellent for deep sandy soils.

306247. Collected about 70 miles northeast of Cuiaba, Mato Grosso. Plant growing on deep sand in very poor soil, averaging to 4 feet high.

306248. *ERAGROSTIS* sp. Gramineae.

Growing at Ociana 100 feet from ocean, used as beach erosion control. Elevation 2 to 3 feet. Growing in deep salty sand, good ground cover, about 6 inches high.

306249. *EYSENHARDTIA* sp. Leguminosae.

Collected near Cuiaba, Mato Grosso.

306250. *LASIACIS* sp. Gramineae.

Collected near Buriti. Plants to 6 feet high, grown in low, shady, rich soil.

306251. *LASIACIS* sp.

Collected near Goias, Mato Grosso border.

306252. *PANICUM* sp. Gramineae.

Collected at Campinas. Good foliage, to 14 inches high, leaves 0.5 inch wide, 4 inches long. Seeds drop readily when mature.

306253. *PANICUM* sp.

Collected at Santos. Possibly used as beach erosion control or on low saline pasture areas.

306254. *PASPALUM* sp. Gramineae.

Collected at Campinas. Plants to 30 inches high, 0.75 inch wide leaves, good foliage. Appears succulent.

306255. *PENNISETUM* sp. Gramineae.

Near Jatai Goias along road.

306256. *SETARIA* sp. Gramineae.

Near Campinas. Plant to 24 inches high, possible use as cattle feed.

306257. *SORGHUM BICOLOR* (L.) Moench Gramineae.

Collected near Jatai, Goias. Plant to 4 feet high, erect.

306258. *SORGHUM* sp.

Collected near Mato Grosso, Goias border, between Jatai and Cuiaba. Possible cattle and wildlife feed.
