307174. Col. No. 876. Sixty-five miles northwest of Misurata, Libya. Flowers white, dehiscent.

Col. No. 867. Eighty-two miles east of Tobruk, Libya. Plant 2.5 feet high, dense clumps. Flowers pale yellow. Seeds from dried heads of 1964.
