307176. **LINUM* sp. Linaceae.

Col. No. 870. Twenty-eight miles west of Bieda, Libya. Roadside with abundant spring flowers. Plants 6–10 inches high, flowers red.

307177. *RICINUS COMMUNIS* L. Euphorbiaceae.

Castorbean.

Col. No. 874. Sixty miles west of Marble Arch, Libya. Roadside in desert. Seed dark mahogany.

307178. *BRASSICA* sp. Cruciferae.

Col. No. 862. Fifteen miles west of Alexandria, United Arab Republic.

307179. *CARDUNCELLUS ERIOCEPHALUS* Boiss. Compositae.

Col. No. 866. In British War Cemetery at El Alamein, United Arab Republic. Probably introduced. Plant 6–10 inches high, perennial, rust on leaves, flowers white.

307180 and 307181. *CARTHAMUS GLAUCUS* ssp. *ALEXANDRINUS* (Boiss. & Heldr.) Hanelt Compositae.

307180. Col. No. 863. Thirty-five miles west of Alexandria, United Arab Republic. Plant. 18–24 inches high, flowers light lavender.

307181. Col. No. 865. Thirty-eight miles west of Alexandria in barley field after harvest.

307182. *CARTHAMUS MAREOTICUS* Delile

Col. No. 861. Ten miles west of Alexandria. Flowers off-white.

307183. *CENTAUREA* sp. Compositae.

Col. No. 864. Twenty-five miles west of Alexandria. Plant low growing, annual, flowers pale yellow.

307190. *ACER CAMPBELLII* Hook. f. & Thoms. Aceraceae.

Col. No. 263. Mt. Tonglu, West Bengal. Elevation 9,000 feet. Deciduous tree to 35 feet. Bud scales red, pointed. Flowers yellow. Seed.
