Col. No. 113. Below Phalut, West Bengal, mixed stand with *Abies* and evergreen oak. Elevation 11,000 feet. Needleleaf evergreen to 60 feet or more. Seed.

307373. *VANDA* sp. Orchidaceae.

Col. No. 162. Palmajua, West Bengal, along trail from Rimbick. Elevation 6,800 feet. Epiphytic. Plant.

307374. *VIBURNUM CORIACEUM* Blume Caprifoliaceae.

Col. No. 261. Lloyds Botanic Garden, Darjeeling, West Bengal. Evergreen shrub. Seed.

307375. *VIBURNUM STELLULATUM* Wall. ex DC.

Col. No. 262. Lloyds Botanic Garden, Darjeeling, West Bengal. Seed.

307376. *ZEPHYRANTHES ROSEA* Lindl. Amaryllidaceae. **Pink zephyrlily.**

Col. No. 138. Near Sirikhula, West Bengal, growing on edge of cultivated terraces. Elevation 8,000 feet. Bulbous perennial, leaves linear. Flowers large, light pink. Plant.

Col. No. 170. Batasi Forest, moist woods, West Bengal. Elevation 7,400 feet. Herbaceous perennial. Stem prostrate on ground. Fruit red, clustered, to one inch in diameter, seeds white, 1 to 4 per fruit. Seed.
