378583. ALOE CRYPTOPODA Baker Liliaceae.

M-21852. Buffelsbock, near Burgersfort. Leaves medium green, slight mottling, margins spiny.

378584. ALOE MARLOTHII A. Berg.

M-21853. Buffelsvlei, near Lydenburg. Leaves narrow, dark green with marginal spines that stand perpendicular to the flat surface of the leaf.

378585. ALOE PETRICOLA Pole-Evans

M-21907. Sunnyside Farm, Nelspruit District. Elevation 1,246 m. Fleshy glaucous leaves have rounded margins, few spines.

378586. ALOE SAPONARIA (Ait.) Haw.

M-21854. Lynwood Road. Leaves fleshy, spines on margins and upper and lower surfaces.

378587. ALOE VOGTSII Reynolds

M-21851. Lynwood Road. Leaves mottled with spiny margins.
