449323. AK 23. 'Rayen'. Chile. Santiago. Empresa Nacional de Semillas (ENDS). Selected from USA cultivar 'Moapa'. Resistant to stem and root-knot nematodes. Cultivated. Seed.

449324. *Phalaris aquatica* L. (Poaceae) Bulbous canarygrass.

From Chile. Collected by W.R. Kehr and R.E. Avendano, USDA, University of Nebraska, and Empresa Nacional de Semillas (ENDS), Lincoln, Nebraska and Santiago. Received April 1980.
