**449428. GLP-2. Roko. Bush type. Seeds large, oblong with red mottled color. Wide tolerance to halo blight and rust. Fair tolerance to angular leaf spot and Bean Common Mosaic Virus. High yield potential. Cultivated. Seed.**

**449429. GLP-24. Canadian Wonder, bush type. Seeds red, medium sized. Grows well in areas with medium rainfall. Susceptible to halo blight, but has some tolerance to rust and angular leaf spot. Cultivated. Breeding material. Seed.**
